- You or your immediate family must be either a primary or secondary owner on a deposit account, a primary owner or co-borrower on a loan account, or a primary owner of an insurance policy.
- Employees and members of the Board of Directors of BankStar Financial, and their immediate families (spouse, parents, siblings, and children, and each of their respective spouses regardless of where they live) and persons living in the households of these individuals, whether related or not, are **not** eligible.

ACADEMIC (Up to 25 points awarded)

- Transcript (including your cumulative GPA & Class Rank) – unofficial is fine
- ACT Score (if available)

ACTIVITIES/COMMUNITY SERVICE (Up to 30 points awarded)

- A list or summary of your activities including extracurricular, volunteer, religious, or other special interest activities. Please include number of years of participation and any contributions you made.
- Describe any employment experiences you've had or include a current resume.

CHARACTER & GOALS (Up to 35 points awarded)

- In 200 words or less describe yourself including your values, academic goals, and career goals.
- BankStar is especially interested in applicants who demonstrate a career interest in the local financial services industry, or a career you may pursue locally.

OVERALL PRESENTATION (Up to 10 points awarded)

- Total application will be reviewed on professional presentation of all materials.
